Agreement

Article I ~ Agreements

Section 1.

1. Rescue Chair/Club Representative has the right to discriminate in the placement of said miniature equine described above with regards to type of home in which it will be placed. It is further agreed and understood that this equine WILL NOT be sold, given away, destroyed, used for animal laboratory experimentation, or otherwise disposed of without first notifying the Petite Equine Assoc., Inc. and giving PEA Rescue the first choice of obtaining the equine. Further the equine above shall not be used for donations, raffles, or give-away promotions, or sold or consigned to pet stores or animal brokers or to anywhere or anyone else other than the Petite Equine Assoc., Inc. rescue program.
2. All equine placed will be wormed, and brought current on vaccinations. Unless, they have already been vaccinated and proof of vaccinations satisfies the rescue requirements.
3. All equine placed through the rescue program are believed to be in good health at the time of adoption. Any pre-existing health issues/concerns will be fully disclosed before the equine is adopted to his/her new home. The Petite Equine Assoc, Inc. makes no guarantee or promise regarding this equine.
4. If an equine proves to be incompatible with the family/new owner, the equine must be return to PEA, Inc., rescue program.
5. All equine turned into the Club rescue program will not have registration papers.
6. New owner shall be encouraged to join the membership of the PEA, Inc. A membership application will be provided.

Section 2.

1. Upon releasing the miniature equine, the Rescue Chair/Club Representative shall do the following:
 - a) Shall supply records, which shall detail inoculations given, including date and type of serum & dates at which future inoculations are due.
 - b) Shall supply a copy of the PEA, Inc. "Code of Ethics" and other related club material when a new owner joins the Club.

- c) Shall release only equine which are, to the best of the Rescue Chair's/Club Representative's knowledge, in good health.
 - d) Shall release an equine that has had the necessary gelding, inoculations, worming, and microchip ID (if microchipped).
2. The Rescue Chair/Club Representative shall be available to the new owner(s) for any reasonable need such as advice, reasonable aid, and assistance they may need for the lifetime of the miniature equine.

Section 3.

1. New owners agrees to notify and give PEA, Inc. rescue program the opportunity to take the miniature equine back for any reason (i.e. relocating, disinterest, unforeseen circumstances, or any other reason) if the new owner can no longer keep the miniature equine.
2. New owners agree to be responsible for the miniature equine at all times and to borne all moral and financial responsibilities for said equine.
3. New owners shall provide a loving home, routine and other necessary medical attention, worming, good nutrition, shelter and a fenced area providing a safe environment.
4. New owners agrees to let Rescue Chair/Club Representative investigate area/home(s)/other, where the miniature equine is going to be kept. If at anytime the Rescue Chair/Club Representative determines that the environment is harmful, distressing or abusive to the miniature equine, the new owners give the Rescue Chair/Club Representative the right to remove and take the back the miniature equine listed in this contract.

Article II ~ Right Of Possession Agreement

We, the owners of this aforementioned miniature equine, do hereby give the Petite Equine Assoc., Inc. Rescue the right to take immediate custody of this miniature equine, at any time, from any person, pound, shelter, Rescue Service, or boarding facility where it may be placed; including all records and/or registration papers.

This statement will release any of the aforementioned persons, or facilities, from any liability or lawsuit, on the part of the owner(s), of this miniature equine for release of the miniature equine to The Petite Equine Assoc, Inc. Rescue.

If this equine belongs to one or more persons/party, and there is a division of properties due to separation and/or divorce, Settlement Agreement; or in the case of the owner(s) demise, Estate Settlement; the miniature equine shall not be held in litigation. Should custody of the miniature equine be in question the Petite Equine Assoc., Inc. Rescue has the right to enforce "Right of Possession"; and immediately assume legal ownership of the miniature equine.

This statement shall also be considered our "Last Will and Testament" on the ownership of the aforementioned miniature equine. In the case of our demise, ownership of this miniature equine, all records, and any papers shall be immediately transferred to the Petite Equine Assoc, Inc. Rescue. This equine shall, in no way, be held in litigation, nor ownership transferred, to any other party not mentioned herein, including relatives or any persons or parties which may lay claim to this said miniature equine for any reason.

This "Right Of Possession" is part of the original "Contract Agreement" between the Petite Equine Assoc, Inc. Rescue and the owner and is duly enforceable by the Petite Equine Assoc., Inc. Rescue at any time, from any person, pound, shelter, facility, or Rescue Organization; for the entire life of the miniature equine.

I/We, testify that no contract, Last Will, sales contract, affidavit, transfer of ownership, nor any other form of documentation will be made concerning the ownership of this miniature equine. Any such documentation, ownership transfer, or Right of Possession, shall not be made following the date of this document. This document shall be the sole enforceable documentation on the custody, or Right Of Possession of this miniature equine. Any, or all, documentation, contracts, etc., either prior to, or following, the signing of this statement shall be considered nil, void, and invalid.

This agreement has been read and understood by The Petite Equine Assoc., Inc. Club, Rescue Chair/Club Representative and the new owner(s) as fact. Should any dispute arise regarding the interpretation or application of the provisions of this agreement, the parties agree to submit such disputes to binding arbitration pursuant to the commercial arbitration rules of the American Arbitration Association.
